The Committee of the Whole recommends:

 - 1. That Tender T16-235 for Curb and Sidewalk Repair and Replacement for the City of Vaughan be awarded to Serve Construction Ltd. for Part 1, in the amount of \$794,526.00, and to Metro Asphalt for Part 2, in the amount of \$710,640.00 plus applicable taxes;
 - 2. That a contingency allowance in the amount of \$150,617.00 (10 percent) plus applicable taxes be approved, within which the Director of Transportation Services, Parks and Forestry Operations is authorized to approve amendments to the contract;
 - 3. That the amounts of the above recommendations, including contingency allowance and applicable taxes be funded from Capital Project RP-2035-15; and
 - 4. That the Mayor and the City Clerk be authorized to sign the necessary documents.

Background

The Transportation Services, Parks and Forestry Operations Department administers the repair and replacement of broken, damaged or hazardous curbs and sidewalks.

The need for curb and sidewalk repairs and replacements is based on Staff inspections and citizen reporting. From the inspections and reporting a master list is developed and priority is assigned to each curb or sidewalk requiring repair and/or replacement. Work is then administered each year from the master list based on the priority assigned to each curb or sidewalk.

Tender T16-235 reflects an integrated approach to curb and sidewalk repair and replacement for the City's parks and roads infrastructure.

The continued integration of the former Parks and Roads Divisions, within Transportation Services, Parks and Forestry Operations, has allowed Staff to identify synergies and opportunities to improve operational performance.

As such, Tender T16-235 has integrated the two (2) separate curb and sidewalk repair and replacement contracts maintained by the former Parks and Roads Divisions into one consolidated contract to increase efficiencies.

In May 2016, the City invited bidders to bid on the Tender T16-235.

Purchasing Services advertised the Tender T16-235 on the City of Vaughan's Bids Opportunities Website, Ontario Public Buyers Association's Website and on Biddingo on May 17 2016, with a closing date of June 2, 2016.

Following the deadline for the submission of bids, Staff will provide a subsequent communication to Committee of the Whole that will include a synopsis of the bid results and an award recommendation.

Background – Analysis and Options

Following the deadline for the submission of bids of Tender T16-235 – Curb and Sidewalk Repair and Replacement, it was determined that the lowest compliant bidder for Part 1 is Serve Construction, and the lowest compliant bidder for Part 2 is Metro Asphalt. It is recommended that Part 1 be awarded to Serve Construction Ltd. and that Part 2 be awarded to Metro Asphalt, accordingly.

The deadline for the submission of bids for Tender T16-235 was June 3, 2016. Five (5) bids were submitted and all bids were compliant.
