**AWARD OF TENDER T16-235 – CURB AND SIDEWALK REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT  
ITEM 32, REPORT NO. 27  
COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE – JUNE 21, 2016**

**Recommendation**

The Deputy City Manager of Public Works and the Director of Transportation Services, Parks and Forestry Operations, in consultation with the Director of Purchasing Services and the Director of Financial Planning and Development Finance recommend:

1. That Tender T16-235 for Curb and Sidewalk Repair and Replacement for the City of Vaughan be awarded to Serve Construction Ltd. for Part 1, in the amount of \$794,526.00, and to Metro Asphalt for Part 2, in the amount of \$710,640.00 plus applicable taxes;
2. That a contingency allowance in the amount of \$150,617.00 (10 percent) plus applicable taxes be approved, within which the Director of Transportation Services, Parks and Forestry Operations is authorized to approve amendments to the contract;
3. That the amounts of the above recommendations, including contingency allowance and applicable taxes be funded from Capital project RP-2035-15; and
4. And that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign the necessary documents.

**Contribution to Sustainability**

This report contributes to the goals and objectives within Green Directions Vaughan, The City's Community Sustainability and Environmental Master Plan, specifically:

Goal 3: To ensure that Vaughan is a city that is easy to get around with a low environmental impact.

Objective 3.2: "To develop and sustain a network of roads that supports efficient and accessible public and private transit".

**Economic Impact**

Funding for the total tender costs in the amount of \$1,506,165.50, plus applicable taxes and contingency is available within the approved capital project of RP-2035-15.

#### **Purpose**

As indicated in Item 32, Report No. 27, from the Committee of the Whole, June 21, 2016, the purpose of this communication is to provide a synopsis of the bid results for Tender T16-235 – Curb and Sidewalk Repair and Replacement and recommend that it be awarded to the lowest compliant bidders for Part 1 and Part 2.

#### **Background – Analysis and Options**

**Following the deadline for the submission of bids of Tender T16-235 – Curb and Sidewalk Repair and Replacement, it was determined that the lowest compliant bidder for Part 1 is Serve Construction, and the lowest compliant bidder for Part 2 is Metro Asphalt. It is recommended that Part 1 be awarded to Serve Construction Ltd. and that Part 2 be awarded to Metro Asphalt, accordingly.**

The deadline for the submission of bids for Tender T16-235 was June 3, 2016. Five (5) bids were submitted and all bids were compliant.


