Hello Committee of the Whole,

During construction my almost 100 year old tree was damaged. The present City of Vaughan By-Law 185-2007 indicates that no person shall injure or damage a tree of certain diameter. I believe that By-Law 185-2007 should be updated to ensure that this kind of damage does not happen again. The By-Law should include barrier protection as outline by other municipality's By-Laws (ie Toronto tree By-Law and Mississuaga By-Law and Richmond Hill tree By-Law).

As I have indicated, the tree on my property is almost 100 years old and stands over 100 feet high and is greater than 10 feet in diameter. It is a Black Walnut tree. The Vaughan tree By-Law should ensure that this does not happen again.
