- 2) That, given that, as per the City's policy, the proceeds from the Mayor's Gala and Charity Golf Tournament will not be distributed in 2014 because of it being an election year, that Members of Council be given the opportunity to submit names to the Mayor's Office by December 2, 2013, of qualifying charities, not for profit organizations and community groups that have not benefitted from grants from the City in 2013.**
