**42      ALLWAY STOP CONTROL AT MISTYSUGAR TRAIL AND TREECREST DRIVE**

***Whereas***, City staff have previously reviewed this location and determined that the all-way stop sign warrant is not likely to be met in the future;

***Whereas***, Bakersfield Public School is located on the south side of Mistysugar Trail at the intersection of Treecrest Drive and an allway stop will provide a safer north-south pedestrian crossing; and

***Whereas***, Mistysugar Park is located on the south side of Mistysugar Trail at the intersection of Treecrest Drive and an allway stop will provide a safer north-south pedestrian crossing; and

***It is therefore resolved that*** an allway stop control be installed at the intersection of Mistysugar Trail and Treecrest Drive as soon as possible.
