The Committee of the Whole at its October 16, 2012 meeting referred the above matter to Staff for additional information.

Staff have reviewed the concerns expressed by the deputant respecting the application process for mobile signs and are suggesting the following recommendations:

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

- That the Building Standards Department revise their current application procedure, which restrict applicants to a one day window of opportunity, for a 6 month trial period to allow applicants for mobile sign permits at least a two week window for applying for permits, and;
- That the trial period commence on January 1, 2013 in order that other Licensed Mobile Sign Operators may be advised and allow time for Mobile Sign Operators and Staff to modify their processes, and;
- 3) That Building Standards Department brings forward a report to Council respecting the results of the trial period 6 months hence.

The above has been discussed with the deputant.

Thank-you for your recent correspondence to Mayor Maurizio Bevilacqua dated February 14, 2012.

Further to your letter, as you may be aware we have reviewed this matter in great detail with Mr. Duffy and we concur with many of his suggestions respecting the need to update and modernize the mobile sign permit process. We agree with you and Mr. Duffy that a number of these suggestions would help improve our current level of customer service. The Planning Commission which includes the Building Standards and Development Planning Departments are looking forward to providing the type of on-line or electronic service that you requesting for many other permit types and other related services.

As discussed in our meeting with Mr. Duffy, modernization will take some time as there are gaps in the City's existing infrastructure that prevents the City from quickly implementing our desired changes.

## **Deputation from Magnetsigns**

### Request for Change in Application Procedure in Building Department

Our company provides mobile signs to many small businesses in Vaughan. Each mobile sign requires a permit and in 2009 over 1100 permits were issued. Permits are obtained in person through the building department and the current "*day before*" application procedure requires almost daily attendance at city hall. <u>This procedure</u> <u>needs to be changed.</u>

The earliest the sign company or taxpayer can make application for the permit is the *day before* the permit starts. Thus if the applicant requires a permit for each day of the week, they have to make a minimum of three and up to five trips to city hall; over a two week period a minimum of five and up to ten trips would be required.

If instead of this *day before* procedure, the city allowed applicants at least a "*two week window*" for applying, the system would be substantially more efficient for all involved. It would

- eliminate the need for multiple trips to city hall resulting in significant cost savings for the applicants,
- the automotive pollution generated would be substantially reduced,
- the small business who wants to rent the sign would know well in advance that they were going to be able to undertake their advertising,



• The City would have significantly fewer transactions to process in the building department, at the cashier, and in the finance department.

### The benefits of this suggested change are easy to see and very tangible.

The only other nearby city that has a procedure similar to Vaughan is Richmond Hill. Brampton offers a 7 day window, while Mississauga, Toronto, Markham, Aurora, Newmarket, Bolton, Oakville, Burlington, offer at least three month windows; many offer up to one year.

I have previously made a request of the building department to change their *day before* procedure however, they have been unwilling to accommodate the request, and offer no reasonable explanation as to why this improvement can't be implemented. On holiday long weekends they already accommodate applications two days before the permit start date, so it is not a computer system issue. The only explanation I can see as to why the department won't adopt this improved procedure is an unwillingness to change.

In summary, I am here today to ask you to intervene in the departments procedures and request an immediate review of the current application procedure - it is a simple issue. It is a procedural issue not related to the bylaw, and I believe my suggested change or something similar can be immediately implemented by providing just a little direction to counter staff and an email to the licenced sign companies. I hope that you are willing to intervene and will quickly force the department to make the improvement. The benefits will be immediate to all involved. Thank you for your time.

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
