Reference: January 23, 2018 Fireworks Deputation

Eagles Nest has been an upstanding business in Vaughan since 2004 prior to many of the subdivisions now located around our property.

As the home to almost 700 social, corporate, and our own charity events to help the community annually, most of which are of the celebratory nature "We sell fun", the use of a fireworks display is a nice touch to an event, and many times a surprise to the guests.

In the past two years, Eagles Nest had 16 groups in 2017 and 11 groups in 2016, which have chosen to use firework displays, of which all had proper City of Vaughan documentation to proceed. Additionally, all displays were performed prior to the allowed cut off time, last a maximum of 5 minutes, and many times would correspond with numerous other holiday fireworks displays in surrounding areas from Eagles Nest. Contrary to the Toronto Star report on Dec 31, 2017, there were no firework displays on Dec 23/17 that pertained to Eagles Nest.

It is not uncommon for our concierge team to receive numerous calls on Fridays asking if there will be firework displays, as many of our neighbours take advantage of hosting backyard parties and have their guests watch the nearby fireworks.

At this current time Eagles Nest is aware of four groups that have already put down deposits for their firework displays for their events for 2018, we certainly hope they won't be forced to lose their money.
