I have been living in Thornhill (Dufferin and Centre area) since January, 1997 and I wish to say that I am very happy to see, finally, something being done to develop the area around Dufferin and Centre.

I am hoping the development includes a few restaurants, cafes, and shops – similar to what was done just north of the Promenade Mall (Disera Drive). If you can make space for a couple of licensed outdoor patios in front of the restaurants, it would also be greatly appreciated as I am tired of having to drive or take taxis to find open patios. (When I drive, I'm suck being the designated driver!)

If mid-rise condos are needed to make the development viable, and if additional stop lights are needed to slow down the traffic, I am perfectly fine with that. At least I can walk there and I can walk home.

Also, I am looking forward to the completion of the bus lanes down Bathurst and Centre so that I can get to work more efficiently.

Unfortunately, my kids will be finished with post-secondary education by the time the bus-lanes are complete, but if they choose to stay in the neighbourhood (perhaps the mid-rise condos!?) they will have some good options for public transportation.

I suspect that this is not the message that Mr. Josh Martow of the Ratepayers Association wanted to hear, but I assure you that it reflect a great number of community residents who just don't have patience to personally attend council meetings.
