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Dear City of Vaughan Council,

I am writing in regards to the City of Vaughan's proposal to build mid-rise condos on the plot of land north of the Dufferin-Centre Tim Horton's plaza. My family and I have lived in this neighbourhood for 10 years and we are strongly opposed to this proposal. Mid-rise condos (ex. 6, 8 and 12 storeys) do not fit in with this neighbourhood of single family detached homes. A small number of town homes or single family dwellings are more appropriate.

My family and I are completely not in favour of a new full-lit (traffic light) intersection on Dufferin Street, about 200 metres north of Centre Street. It is outrageous to place a new traffic signal intersection so close to Dufferin and Centre Streets. The traffic in this area is already terrible, and a new set of traffic lights so close to the existing lights will increase, not alleviate, the traffic problems we already have.

Although I am unable to attend the council meeting on June 20 at 1:00 because I am working, please take my concerns into account when making your decisions regarding this area. As a taxpayer and long-time resident of this neighbourhood, I expect my concerns to be taken seriously and addressed appropriately.
