On **Tuesday**, **June 28**, **2016**, the Policy Planning & Environmental Sustainability Department and the City's lead consultant, The Planning Partnership will be hosting a Public Open House meeting in regard to the Dufferin Street and Centre Street Intersection Study. The lands subject to the study includes all 4 quadrants of the Dufferin Street and Centre Street intersection, as shown on the Study Area Map. (see below)

On April 23, 2013 Vaughan Council directed that a Study be initiated for the subject lands. The study will consider the appropriate land uses, heights and densities and urban design objectives for the area for the purpose of preparing Official Plan policies to guide the future development or redevelopment of the area, for consideration by Council.

The purpose of the meeting is to introduce the study, the project team, provide background on existing land uses, policies and infrastructure, and discuss the overall work plan with the public. The meeting will include a presentation by the lead consultant and it will be followed by a discussion, which will provide an opportunity for the public to provide comment and input on the study.
