On **Thursday, November 3, 2016**, the Policy Planning & Environmental Sustainability Department and the City's lead consultant, The Planning Partnership will be hosting a second Public Open House meeting on the Dufferin Street and Centre Street Intersection Land Use Study. The lands subject to the study includes all 4 quadrants of the Dufferin Street and Centre Street intersection, as shown on the Study Area Map. (see below)

On April 23, 2013 Vaughan Council directed that a study be initiated for the subject lands. The study will consider the appropriate land uses, heights and densities and urban design objectives for the area for the purpose of preparing Official Plan policies to guide the future development or redevelopment of the area, for consideration by Council.

The study team has completed its initial work and has prepared a conceptual land use and development plan. The purpose of the meeting is to provide a project status update, gather public input on the initial concept and to discuss next steps. The meeting will include a presentation of the draft conceptual plan followed by a discussion, which will provide an opportunity to receive comment and input that will assist in finalizing the study and resulting plan.
