During the November 26, 2012 Finance & Administration Committee meeting, Council requested staff to provide a prioritized Capital from Taxation list. In response, staff have provided the enclosed information.

Background

The 2013-2016 capital budget process began with a departmental review of the Council recognized 2013 capital projects adjusted for new requirements and changing trends. Projects were then further vetted by Finance department staff, the Directors Working Group, and Senior Management and placed into categories reflecting various degrees of priority. Within each category, department provided project rankings were used to assist in the prioritization of the projects within the available funding. As a result of this exercise projects that could not be funded for the year submitted were deferred to future years and given a priority standing within the future year category. It should also be noted, projects submitted as part of the Community Infrastructure Improvement Fund (CIIF) were given higher priority within the category to reflect the potential of receiving additional funding.

Listed below are the priority categories for Capital from Taxation projects:

1. Legal/Regulatory/Health & Safety – Projects for which there is a financial/legal/regulatory commitment or a health and safety component that if not undertaken puts the City at risk.
2. Growth (co-funding) – There is an underlying commitment to support the City's development charge (DC) agreement and maintain DC collection service levels. It should be noted the majority of the project, typically 90%, is funded by the development industry.
3. Priority Initiatives – Council endorsed priority projects supporting corporate "City Building" initiatives intended to help the City progress towards its Vision.
4. Technology/Replacement – These projects support existing City infrastructure and are further subdivided into the following:
 - Established annual programs
 - Individual replacement/upgrade projects
5. New – These projects are new items or service levels, which are either not included in the development charge document and/or do not have any other funding source.

The projects within each category have been re-sorted to reflect the initiating department's priority order wherever possible.

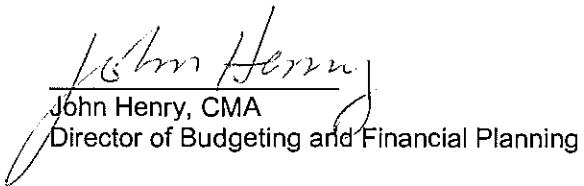
The end result of this analysis can be found on the attached project listing for Capital from Taxation.
