Purpose

The purpose of this staff report is to advise members of Council of the matters dealt with under the Consolidated Purchasing Policy No. PS-003 section 6.4.

Background - Analysis and Options

Consolidated Purchasing Policy No. PS-003 section 6.4 provides the Director of Purchasing authority for the award of contracts resulting from a request for tender upon recommendation from a Commissioner, where the total cost of any goods, services or construction exceeds one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) but does not exceed three hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) and the following criteria have been met:

- 1. The award is to the lowest priced compliant bidder;
- 2. The award of the contract is within the approved budget;
- 3. The award results from the normal tendering process of the City (i.e. open bidding through advertisements;
- 4. The term of the contract is for a maximum of the four years;
- 5. There is no litigation between the successful bidder and the City at the time of award; and
- 6. There are no bidder protests at the time of contract award.

All bid results are posted on the City of Vaughan's new portal Bids & Tenders right after Bid openings. However, following is a consolidated report of all award approvals made within \$100,000.00 to \$350,000.00 threshold:

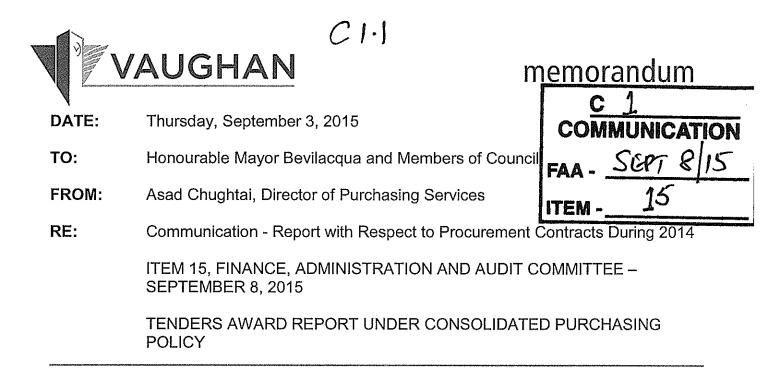

<u>Purpose</u>

To provide a report to the Finance, Administration and Audit Committee in response to the "New Business" motion regarding Item 14, Report No. 10 adopted by the Council on June 23, 2015 requesting the following:

"That the Director of Purchasing provide a report on the number of contracts extended since January 1, 2014 and the number of the contracts that were extended beyond the option years"

Background

The inclusion of contract extensions in procurement bid documents is a common practice and element of the procurement process. Contract extensions are intended to ensure continuity of services delivery, cost effectiveness and provide operational flexibility to adjust to changing demands and performance requirements. The contract term and optional extension periods are determined by the service department in consultation with purchasing services. Optional extensions are authorized by the service department and subject to performance satisfaction and budget availability. Contract extensions beyond optional extension periods are only considered and permitted under extenuating circumstances. The majority of these contracts will go to Council for approval. In all other cases, a new procurement process is conducted within the Purchasing Policy framework.

Since January 2014, staff has exercised optional extensions for contracts in accordance with the terms and provisions outlined in respective contracts. Details of contracts extended within the optional terms are provided in Attachment 1.

Attachment 2 identifies the contracts recommended and amended to add extensions beyond the optional terms. Service departments make recommendations for additional extensions beyond available options only under special circumstances. For instance, the Winter Road Maintenance contract was extended as winter control programs operational review was underway, a report for which was submitted to Council. In another instance, existing contracts were allowed to continue to ensure uninterrupted service delivery while procurement process for a new service provider was ongoing.



Conclusion

It is a standard practice to incorporate optional extension terms in medium to long term contracts as they provide the necessary buffer and flexibility to maintain important and essential services without disruption. Such provisions give the necessary capability to not exercise contract extension should the performance be unsatisfactory while providing necessary time needed to solicit and execute a new contract. In limited cases, an extension beyond the optional terms may be necessitated and approved by Director of Purchasing upon recommendation from the respective department heads on a month-to-month basis to ensure continuity of service delivery. All contracts are extended in accordance with the terms and amendment provisions available within the respective contracts. Extensions are exercised by respective department heads and Commissioners in order to ensure consistent uninterrupted service delivery to the City.
