TRCA WATERCOURSE SIGNAGE WITHIN WOODBRIDGE, MAPLE AND THORNHILL HERITAGE CONSERVIATION DISTRICTS – WARDS 1, 2, 5

RECOMMENDATION

1. That the proposed Humber and Don River watercourse signage for the Woodbridge, Maple and Thornhill Heritage Conservation Districts, as recommended by TRCA, be approved.

Contribution to Sustainability

This report is consistent with the priorities previously set by Council in the Green Directions, Vaughan, Community Sustainability Environmental Master Plan, Goal 4, and Objective 4.1:

 To foster a city with strong social cohesion, an engaging arts scene, and a clear sense of its culture and heritage.

Economic Impact

The cost of manufacturing and installing the subject signage has been approved and is shared between the Region, TRCA and the City of Vaughan.

Communications Plan

Recommendations and approvals resulting in the review of this matter will be forwarded to the required authorities and proponents.

Purpose

The purpose of this report is to review and approve the proposed signage by TRCA related to identifying the Humber and Don River watercourses to be installed within the Woodbridge, Maple and Thornhill Heritage Conservation District.

Background - Analysis and Options

TRCA in an ongoing program to identify watercourses of the Humber and Don River systems, is proposing to install signs located within or near the Woodbridge, Maple and Thornhill Heritage Conservation Districts to promote the two river system and the Humber as a heritage river. The sign locations proposed are as follows:

- 1. Maple- Major Mackenzie Drive east of McNaughton Road (two Regional signs north and south of road).
- 2. Maple Keele Street at Knightswood Avenue, north or Rutherford Road (two Regional signs west and east of road).
- 3. Thornhill Yonge Street between Thornhill Avenue and Centre Street (one Regional sign on west side).
- 4. Woodbridge to replace existing sign on Highway 7 at Islington Avenue (one Regional sign on north side).
- 5. Woodbridge Clarence Avenue south of Mounsey Street (two municipal signs west and east side).
- 6. Woodbridge Islington Avenue south of Wakelin Court (two Regional signs west and east side of road).
- 7. Woodbridge –Woodbridge Avenue west of Islington Avenue (two municipal signs on north and south side of road).

The signs are made of aluminum and are installed in the ground using 4X4 posts. They are non-illuminated.

The signs proposed on Regional roads are 48" by 20" in size. The signs proposed on municipal roads are 36" by 15" in size.
