SIGN VARIANCE APPLICATION, 10432 ISLINGTON AVENUE, KLEINBURG-NASHVILLE HERITAGE CONSERVATION DISTRICT – WARD 1

Recommendation

1. That Heritage Vaughan recommend to the Sign Variance committee, that Sign Variance Application SV.13-00 for a third party development sign at 10432 Islington Avenue, not be permitted.

Purpose

The purpose of this report is to review the proposed Sign Variance application relating to a property within the Kleinburg-Nashville Heritage Conservation District, 10432 Islington Avenue, a vacant former car garage/gas station.

Background - Analysis and Options

Heritage Vaughan committee may comment on proposed sign variance applications that pertain to properties within Vaughan's four heritage conservation Districts.

The proposed signage for the KN-Heritage District is for a third party development ground sign promoting a new subdivision in Kleinburg. The site of the sign is along Islington Avenue and in a vacant property, once the location of a car garage and gas station.

The sign is 8 feet wide, 12 feet in height and sits on a 3 feet from the ground. Wood posts support the structure. The sign is within the height requirements for development signs in Vaughan, however, due to its location in the Special Sign District, where such large third party signs are not permitted, the applicant requires a variance for its installation.

The KN Heritage Conservation District design guidelines do not permit ground signs and in particular signs of this size.
