As the Chairman of the City of Vaughan Official Plan Review Committee, it is with great pleasure that I am sending you this education curriculum package that has been prepared as part of the City of Vaughan's Official Plan process. The package includes an 18-minute video addressing some of the challenges our City is currently facing and a teacher's package that sets out some issues and questions for leading a class discussion and/or independent student exercise. This package provides students in Vaughan with an excellent opportunity to engage with issues facing their City and to get involved in a city-wide process that will guide growth in Vaughan over the next 30 years.

The City of Vaughan has set a high standard for engaging youth in civic issues. We have appointed a Youth Councillor who has office space at City Hall and attends all Council Meetings. We have an active Youth Committee who organize an annual Youth Forum. Last year, three high school classes chose to take part in our city-wide Visioning exercise by creating videos addressing the issues that youth thought important to include in the new Official Plan. We believe that actively engaging our youth in critical civic issues will make them both better students and better citizens.

The enclosed package is timely and easy to use. Its main purpose is to inform youth about the challenges and opportunities in their communities and engage them in an informed discussion about these issues. We believe that it aligns well with a variety of topics and curriculum requirements for your students and hope that you will use it in your school.
