Improvements are Underway

The City of Vaughan is undertaking important municipal infrastructure improvements on Old Weston Road, from Weston Road to Steeles Avenue West, including watermain replacement and road work. These enhancements support the City's continued commitment to ensuring long-term sustainability of municipal infrastructure.

Construction is scheduled to commence on April 1, 2022, weather permitting.

Construction Scope and Timelines

Watermain improvements include municipal water service connections up to the property line. Road improvements include the replacement of the top layer (lift) of asphalt pavement within the Old Weston Road right-of-way.

Property owners are reminded that underground systems, such as lawn sprinklers, heated driveways, electrical conduits, or landscaping, etc., within City-owned boulevards or property limits, may be impacted by the proposed construction work. **Removing privately-owned underground systems in advance of construction, at the owner's expense, is recommended.** The City is not responsible for any damages that may occur during construction to privately-owned items within City property limits (Encroachment By-law No. 034-2017).

In advance of any planned work on private property, property owners are asked to contact the City of Vaughan to facilitate coordination.



For Your Information

Roads will remain open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic during construction. Temporary lane restrictions will be required to allow for construction activities to proceed in a safe and efficient manner.

Access to private driveways and entrances may be impacted at times during watermain installation and associated restoration works. Work at the location of commercial entrances will be staged to maintain continued access during business hours.
