# Stormwater Management Facility Improvements

#### **Project Update**

As part of the 2021 Capital Works Program, the City of Vaughan is planning improvements to various Stormwater Management Facility (SWMF) locations. Stormwater management facilities are designed and built to collect rainfall and surface water runoff.

Starting the week of November 15, 2021, the City will begin construction work to retrofit the Blackburn Stormwater Management Pond located behind Blackburn Boulevard. Construction is anticipated to be completed by summer 2022.

#### **Construction Scope**

The scope of work includes the cleaning and grading of the Blackburn Stormwater Management Facility and the replacement of existing stormwater infrastructure adjacent to the pond.

#### **Construction Impacts**

Roads will remain open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic during construction. Temporary traffic diversions will be required at times to allow construction activities to proceed in a safe and efficient manner.

Please Note: Dumping is not permitted in the City of Vaughan and is enforceable under the Littering and Dumping By-law (No. 3-2004), as amended. Individuals found dumping are subject to a maximum fine of \$5,000 per offence.


