Stormwater Management Facility Improvements

Project Update

As part of the 2021 Capital Works Program, the City of Vaughan is planning improvements to various Stormwater Management Facility (SWMF) locations. Stormwater management facilities are designed and built to collect rainfall and surface water runoff.

In early 2022, the City will begin construction work to retrofit Franklin Pond and Pondview Pond, as well as local storm sewer improvements at the east end of Franklin Avenue. Construction is anticipated to be completed by summer 2022.

Construction Scope

The scope of work includes the retrofit of Franklin Pond, the cleaning and grading of Pondview Pond and the construction of catch basins and storm sewers on Franklin Avenue and Hefhill Park.

Construction Impacts

Roads will remain open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic during construction. Temporary traffic diversions and pedestrian detours will be required at times to allow construction activities to proceed in a safe and efficient manner.


