# Watermain, Streetlighting and Road Improvements

## What improvements are being made?

The City of Vaughan is undertaking important municipal infrastructure improvements in your community, including watermain replacement, road rehabilitation and streetlighting upgrades.

Watermain improvements include municipal water service connections up to the property line; refer to enclosed diagram. Road improvements include new top course asphalt, improved road drainage and new LED streetlighting to enhance visibility. These enhancements support the City's continued commitment to ensuring long-term sustainability of municipal infrastructure.


Construction is scheduled to commence in early July, with anticipated completion by July 2023.

### **Construction Impacts**

Roads will remain open to local traffic throughout construction. Temporary staged traffic diversions and pedestrian detours will be required to allow construction activities to proceed in a safe and efficient manner. Access to private driveways and entrances may be impacted at times during construction.

#### **Construction locations:**



# **For Your Information**

Property owners are reminded that underground systems, such as lawn sprinklers, heated driveways, electrical conduits, or landscaping, etc., within City-owned boulevards or property limits, may be impacted by the proposed construction work. **Removing privately-owned underground systems in advance of construction, at the owner's expense, is recommended.** The City is not responsible for any damages that may occur during construction to privately-owned items within City property limits (Encroachment By-law No. 034-2017).

In advance of any planned work on private property, property owners are asked to contact the City of Vaughan to facilitate coordination.
