# What improvements are being made?

The City of Vaughan is undertaking important municipal infrastructure improvements in your area, including watermain replacement, drainage improvements, storm and sanitary sewer enhancements, and road reconstruction work. These enhancements support the City's continued commitment to ensuring long-term sustainability of municipal infrastructure.

Construction is scheduled to commence the week of September 13, 2021, with anticipated completion by June 2022.

## **Construction Scope**

Construction will include road rehabilitation, watermain replacement including water service connections up to the property line, and sanitary sewer and storm sewer renewals, as identified on the enclosed map.





Property owners are reminded that underground systems, such as lawn sprinklers, heated driveways, electrical conduits, or landscaping, etc., within City-owned boulevards or property limits, may be impacted by the proposed construction work. **Removing privately-owned underground systems in advance of construction, at the owner's expense, is recommended.** The City is not responsible for any damages that may occur during construction to privately-owned items within City property limits (Encroachment By-law No. 034-2017).





#### **For Your Information**

Roads will remain open to vehicular and pedestrian traffic during construction. Temporary lane restrictions will be required to allow for construction activities to proceed in a safe and efficient manner.

Access to private driveways will be impacted at times during localized curb replacement and associated restoration works.

Your waste collection day will not change during construction.
