



Active Transportation Facilities: New Multi-Use Pathway and Streetlights

PLANNED PROJECT WORK

The City of Vaughan will be undertaking the detailed design work for a new asphalt multi-use pathway and streetlighting on the east side of Keele Street, from Teston Road to Kirby Road. The proposed multi-use pathway will further improve the overall Active Transportation network within the city and provide safe pedestrian and cyclist access to the North Maple Regional Park.

Construction is expected to begin in spring of 2022.

PRE-CONSTRUCTION FIELD WORK

Commencing December 2020, the City will be conducting investigation activities in the area which may include topographic and/or legal surveys, geotechnical boreholes and other field investigation works. All work is being carried out by the City's consultant, under the direction of the Infrastructure Delivery department. To identify any conflicts, the various underground utilities (i.e. gas, telecommunication, and hydro) will be identified in advance by different coloured paint markings.

TRAFFIC IMPACT

All roads will remain open to traffic during the field investigation work.
