



Active Transportation Facilities: Jane Street

PLANNED PROJECT WORK

The section of Jane Street, between Portage Parkway and Teston Road, is identified as a high priority route to complement the City of Vaughan's cycling and pedestrian network. The City will be commencing the preliminary design work of on-boulevard active transportation facilities (such as sidewalks and cycle tracks), topographic survey, and traffic study within the project limit.

PRE-DESIGN FIELD WORK

As part of the planned work, the City will be conducting investigation activities in the area which may include topographic and/or legal surveys, and traffic data collection. The various underground utilities (i.e. gas, telephone and hydro) will be identified in advance by different coloured paint markings, that will inform the preliminary design in mitigating any conflicts.

TRAFFIC IMPACT

All roads and sidewalks will remain open to traffic while the field investigation work is being carried out by the consultant, under the direction of the Infrastructure Delivery department.
