



Huntington Road Reconstruction

PLANNED PROJECT WORK

The Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) study for Huntington Road recommends urbanizing and widening the subject reach from Langstaff Road to Nashville Road.

The City has retained the services of consulting engineers to undertake the detailed design for the subject road. The project includes roadway reconstruction, road widening, implementation of multi-use pathways and sidewalks, intersections upgrade, utility relocations, and stormwater management. The construction is scheduled for 2023.

PRE-CONSTRUCTION FIELD WORK

Between July to October 2020, the City will be conducting investigation activities in your area which may include topographic and/or legal surveys, geotechnical boreholes and other field investigation works. The various underground utilities (i.e. gas, telecommunication and hydro) will be identified by different coloured paint or flag markings.

TRAFFIC IMPACT

All roads will remain open to traffic while the field investigation work is being carried out by City staff or the City-approved consultant, under the direction of the Infrastructure Delivery department.
