What improvements are being made?

The City of Vaughan is undertaking important municipal infrastructure improvements in your area, including watermain rehabilitation and road reconstruction work. These enhancements support the City's continued commitment to ensuring long-term sustainability of municipal infrastructure.

The tender process – to retain a qualified contractor for this project – is expected to be completed later this month.

Construction Scope

Construction will include watermain and road rehabilitation, as identified on the enclosed map.


Location: Coles Avenue, from Angelina Avenue to end of cul-de-sac

Property owners are reminded that underground systems, such as lawn sprinklers, heated driveways, electrical conduits, or landscaping, etc., within City-owned boulevards or property limits, may be impacted by the proposed construction work. **Removing privately-owned underground systems in advance of construction, at the owner's expense, is recommended.** The City is not responsible for any damages that may occur during construction to privately-owned items within City property limits (Encroachment By-law No. 034-2017).
