

Blue Willow Area Road Rehabilitation

PLANNED WORK

The City of Vaughan is planning to rehabilitate various roads in the Blue Willow Area as part of the 2020 Capital Works Program. The City is currently conducting investigation activities for the project which may include topographic and/or legal surveys, geotechnical boreholes and other field investigation works. The various underground utilities (i.e. gas, Bell and hydro) will be marked out using different colours of paint.

TRAFFIC IMPACT ON LOCAL RESIDENTS

All roads will remain open to traffic while the field investigation work is being carried out by either City staff or a City approved consultant, under the direction of the Infrastructure Delivery Department.

Newsletter No. 3 will be issued prior to construction. The newsletter will provide further details and an approximate start and end date for construction. The road rehabilitation work is tentatively being scheduled for 2020.
