

NEWSLETTER No. 1:

Clark Avenue West - Road Rehabilitation and Watermain Replacement

December 7, 2017

The City of Vaughan is planning to undertake work to improve the existing road and watermain infrastructures on Clark Avenue West.

PLANNED WORK

The project is currently at the preliminary design stage. During the remainder of 2017 and the early months of 2018, the City will be undertaking investigation activities for the project which includes topographic and/or legal surveys, geotechnical boreholes and other field investigation works. The various underground utilities (i.e. Gas, Bell and Hydro) will be marked out using different colours of paint.

A Clark Avenue West bikeway feasibility study is also underway. The feasibility study will investigate and identify opportunities for the construction of bikeway facilities on Clark Avenue West from Dufferin Street to Yonge Street.

The watermain replacement between Bathurst Street and Yonge Street is planned to start in late spring 2019 would be completed in late fall of that year. The road rehabilitation between Dufferin Street and Yonge Street is planned to follow in 2020 and would be coordinated with the construction of the preferred bikeway facility identified through the feasibility study.

Newsletter(s) providing additional details on the project as well as the construction timelines will be issued prior to commencement of construction in 2019 and 2020.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACT ON RESIDENTS AND TRAFFIC

All roads will remain open to traffic while the field investigation work is being carried out by either City staff or a City approved consultant, under the direction of the Infrastructure Delivery Department.

Property owners are reminded that underground systems such as lawn sprinklers, heated driveways and electrical conduits etc. may be within the City-owned boulevard or property limits and may be impacted by the proposed construction work. The City will not be responsible for damage to any privately-owned items that are within the City-owned boulevard or property limits (Encroachment By-law no. 244-2005).


