

NEWSLETTER No. 2:

Clark Avenue West – Road Rehabilitation and Watermain Replacement

February 8, 2019

The City of Vaughan has completed the detailed design phase for the replacement of the existing watermain on Clark Avenue West from Bathurst Street to Yonge Street. Construction is planned to proceed in Spring of this year.

Road rehabilitation on Clark Avenue extending from Yonge Street to west of Dufferin is planned to follow in 2020 along with the construction of inboulevard cycling facilities. An updated newsletter will follow upon completion of the detailed design phase of this work.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS ON LOCAL RESIDENTS AND TRAFFIC

The roadway will remain open for two-way traffic during the watermain construction; however, lane closures will be required.

As a measure to minimize the overall impacts of this project, certain portions of the construction work will be staged and completed during the overnight hours. A noise by-law exemption will be arranged for this project in accordance with By-law 96-2006.

Another newsletter will be circulated later this Spring providing construction timelines and further details prior to commencement of the watermain construction.


