





### within the HCD:

• The management of heritage resources and/or properties within the boundary of the Woodbridge HCD must be in accordance with the policies and guidelines of the Woodbridge HCD Plan.

### beyond the HCD:

- must be sympathetic to the heritage character and attributes described in the Woodbridge HCD Plan and
- provide an appropriate transition.

#### adjacent to listed or designated properties:

 must be sympathetic to the heritage character and attributes identified as part of the listing and/or in the Designation Report.
