YORK REGION RAPID TRANSIT UPDATE <u>CITY-WIDE</u>

The Priorities and Key Initiatives Committee recommends:

- 1) That the recommendation contained in the following report of the Commissioner of Engineering and Public Works, dated April 15, 2013, be approved;
- 2) That Metrolinx be urged to immediately provide \$100 million to allow the Yonge North Subway Extension to continue into the preliminary engineering stage of development; and
- 3) That Communication C4, titled "York Region Rapid Transit Corporation", dated April 15, 2013, be received.

Background – Analysis and Options

The construction of the Toronto-York Spadina Subway Extension is well underway. The first stage of the VivaNext Rapidway in Vaughan, which extends along Highway 7 from Edgely Boulevard to approximately Bowes Road, is scheduled to be completed concurrently with the opening of the Toronto-York Spadina Subway Extension in 2016.

On November 26, 2012, Metrolinx announced the next wave of The Big Move transit projects including the Yonge subway line north into Vaughan. Accordingly, staff has arranged a presentation from YRRTC staff which will touch on the status of the following transit projects:



June 2007 – MoveOntario 2020

Yonge Subway Extension was one of 52 rapid transit projects

October 2008 – Transit Project Assessment Process (TPAP)

The TTC and the City of Toronto became co-proponents

November 2008 – Metrolinx Regional Transportation Plan

Yonge Subway Extension one of the Top 15 Priorities

April 2009 – Transit Project Assessment Approved by the MOE

Approval granted with no conditions



- Subway Conceptual Design Study in April » Staff presented the findings of the Yonge 2012
- > Board endorsed the findings of the Conceptual Design Study
- Staff were authorized to complete an amendment to the Transit Project Assessment Process (TPAP) to incorporate the train storage facility
- proceed with the TPAP amendment in TTC Commission authorized staff to May 2012 A
- » Staff committed to reporting back to the Board prior to going out to the public



Yonge North Subway Extension Tail Track TPAP Update



- » Proposed Public Consultation process*:
- » Technical Advisory Committee March 18
- » Richmond Hill Committee of the Whole April 15
- » Public Consultation May 1
- Staff will report back to the Board in May with the preliminary preferred option for train storage
- » A second round of consultation is planned for June to present the preferred option, impacts, and mitigation
- The TPAP amendment will be filed on the public record in the Fall


