CONSOLIDATION OF REGULATORY BY-LAWS AND LICENSING AMENDMENTS TO PROVIDE REGULATORY RELIEF TO REGISTERED CHARITIES

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE (2) - Wednesday, May 20, 2020

On May 20, 2020, the City of Vaughan Committee of the Whole will consider and receive input from the public on a staff report to introduce a new consolidated Dumping and Littering By-law, to make technical amendments to other by-laws, and to establish provisions within the Licensing By-law to address activities undertaken by registered charities. Proposed amendments to the Licensing By-law include:

- 1. the establishment of a process for registered charities to apply for regulatory relief under the Licensing By-law;
- 2. criteria for assessing and granting the regulatory relief; and
- 3. conditional licensing requirements.
