Tree Protection By-Law 185-2007

Subsection 3(1) of By-Law 185-2007 provides that:

No person shall, within the City's boundaries, injure or destroy any one (1) or more trees having a tree diameter of twenty (20) centimetres or more or having a base diameter of twenty (20) centimetres or more unless authorized by permit to do so pursuant to this by-law.

"Tree Diameter" is defined as:

The measurement of the diameter of the trunk of a tree from outside the bark 1.4 metres above existing grade of the ground adjoining its base or where there are multiple stems on a tree, means the total of the diameters of the three (3) largest stems measured approximately 140 centimetres above existing grade.
