

**Project:** Oakbank Pond Aeration System (VAU-001)

## Updated: March 22, 2018

## **Description:**

A stormwater pond is a man-made pond used to manage water runoff from urban areas.

Oakbank Pond is a self-contained pond (no external connections) that receives over land runoff (water flowing naturally over land) from the surrounding neighbourhood. The pond supports various amphibians and wildlife. Due to urbanization pressures, the pond requires aeration (transfer of oxygen) to promote and sustain pond health.

An aeration system that pumps oxygen into the pond will be installed to promote pond health.

## Benefits to Community & Environment:

The aeration system will increase water quality, remove foul odours, reduce the risk of algae blooms, and help with mosquito control.
