
## PURPOSE OF THE REPORT





## **Background: Vaughan Tomorrow**

- Vaughan Official Plan 2010 adopted in September 2010;
- Part of "Vaughan Tomorrow" the City's Growth Management Strategy to accommodate growth to 2031;
- Program involved the coordination of City policy documents:
  - Vaughan Vision 20/20
  - > Green Directions Vaughan (new initiative)
  - Official Plan Review/Municipal Comprehensive Review (resulted in VOP 2010)
  - Supporting Infrastructure and Servicing Master Plans
- Council direction to proceed-February 2007; Budget-\$5 million






## **Vaughan Tomorrow**

## **Basis for Proceeding with the Update**


- Provincial Growth Plan <u>Amendment No. 2</u> providing for population and employment growth to 2041 was approved 2013;
- York Region Municipal Comprehensive Review and Five Year
   Statutory OP are underway: Includes a policy review, allocation
   of population and employment to the local municipalities to 2041
   and development scenario;
- This includes the extent of any boundary expansions and intensification targets;
- Regional Council expected to confirm a preferred development scenario as the basis for the draft Regional OPA later this year;
- Adoption of the Regional OPA is planned for late 2016.





- VOP 2010 first approvals in 2012 Statutory 5 year review due;
- City OP has to conform to the Growth Plan and Regional Plan;
- Province is requiring Growth Plan conformity by June 2018;
- To meet the Provincial target our <u>Municipal Comprehensive</u> <u>Review</u>, along with the Statutory 5 year Official Plan Review should start in 2016;
- The result will be an amended Vaughan Official Plan 2010 and not a replacement;
- The work will be targeted and the resulting changes minimized, which will reduce the potential for appeals.






# Scope of the City's Growth Management Review

The following Plans will be updated concurrently to accommodate the 2041 population/employment targets:

- VOP 2010
- Green Directions Vaughan
- Active Together Master Plan
- Water Wastewater Master Plan
- Transportation Master Plan
- Storm Drainage and Storm Water Management Master Plan
- Development Charge Study
- Employment Section/Economic Development Strategy






# **Project Duration and Time Line**

- Expected to take 3 4 years (2016 2019);
- Master Plan updates will be completed throughout the process;
- The various Plans are intended to inform the preparation of the other plans and support their implementation;
- Intention is to minimize silos and promote collaboration will need to be reflected in the projects' organizational structure;
- Timing does not include the resolution of OMB appeals resulting from the amended VOP 2010;
- Provisional timeline identifies the key milestones;
- Greater certainty will be provided prior to the initiation of the review.




# **Budget Implications**

- Funding for Official Plan Review/Master Plans now being confirmed through the 2016 Capital Budget process;
- Cumulative impact estimated at approximately \$3.7 million broken down by:

Taxation \$ 214,809 Engineering DCs \$1,418,600 General DCs \$1,943,314 \$3,639,723

Approval of Budget will provide the basis for proceeding.





# **Next Steps**


- Process will be refined on the basis of the following:
  - Approval of the Budget;
  - > The availability of the draft ROPA including:
    - The preferred development scenario
    - Population and employment projections
    - The need for urban boundary expansions/land use conversions (Employment to Non-Employment Uses)
    - Policies identified by the Region for amendment
  - > Any City initiated amendments to VOP 2010
  - > Establish the internal operating protocols
  - > The initiation of the project branding processes





- Will serve to guide the procurement process for consulting assistance
- Report back to Council in approximately six months with a project update including:
  - > A Refined Scope of Work
  - > Budget and Timeline
  - > Project Charter
  - > Organizational Arrangements






## Recommendation

The Deputy City Manager, Planning & Growth Management and the Director of Policy Planning & Environmental Sustainability, in consultation with the Corporate Management Team, recommend:

- 1. That staff proceed with the updating of the City's Growth Management Strategy 2031 (*Vaughan Tomorrow*) to accommodate the growth of the City to the horizon year of 2041 (the "Growth Management Strategy 2041"), as provided for in Amendment 2 to the Growth Plan for the Greater Golden Horseshoe;
- 2. That the funding for the work associated with the completion of the Growth Management Strategy 2041 Review and the Municipal Comprehensive Review/Five-Year Official Plan Review) be confirmed through the Capital Budget approval process for the years 2016-2019;
- 3. That an internal staff technical team, including expertise from various departments, which reports regularly to the Corporate Management Team, be established to support and coordinate the updating of the Growth Management Strategy to 2041 and the combined Municipal Comprehensive Review/Five Year Official Plan Review;





- 4. That in undertaking this work, staff report on a quarterly or as needed basis to the Priorities and Key Initiatives Committee, or such alternative as may be established by Council, in order to provide status updates and obtain direction where required;
- 5. That staff proceed with the preparation and issuance of a Request for Proposal to retain consulting services to undertake the City's Municipal Comprehensive Review and the Five-Year Official Plan Review;
- 6. That prior to the issuance of the Request for Proposal for the Municipal Comprehensive Review/Five-year Official Plan Review, staff report to the Priorities and Key Initiatives Committee to provide an update on the progress to-date; advise of new information pertinent to the project; and confirm such matters as the expected timeline and project charter;
- 7. That through the assistance of Corporate Communications, a branding exercise be undertaken for the Growth Management Strategy 2041, to distinguish its role as the successor to Vaughan Tomorrow, as part of an overall communications strategy and plan.
