The theatrical PXL Gallery, a monumental 10,000 square foot LED light wall installed on the south façade of Transit City Tower 3 on the west side of Millway Avenue between Portage Parkway and Apple Mill Road, reveals a fusion of hightech, low-resolution digital media by renowned digital artists, activated nightly through rotating exhibits of curated moving artwork.
