
Watermain Replacement and Road Rehabilitation on McKenzie Street

The City of Vaughan has commenced detailed design of the proposed road rehabilitation and watermain improvements on McKenzie Street. (See map below.) The road will be reconstructed, and the existing watermain will be replaced. This project is being planned in accordance with the requirements of the Environmental Assessment Act, R.S.O. 1990c.E18.

A key component of the design is consultation with interested stakeholders at a Public Information Centre (P.I.C.). Attendees of this P.I.C. will have the opportunity to meet with the project team and review the current design. The purpose of the P.I.C. is to present the proposed design and obtain public input.

The proposed construction is tentatively scheduled to commence in the spring of 2014. Some of the key issues to be discussed are as follows:

- The presence of existing watermain on private property
- Roadside drainage
