INSTRUCTIONS FOR WORKING SESSION

Part 1 – Hopes and Concerns (20 minutes total)

- · Come up with a list of your Top 10 hopes for the study area
- Next develop a list of their top 10 concerns or things that should be avoided in the study area.
- Each group will be asked to present their top two hopes and top two concerns from their group's list. These will be recorded on flip charts at the front. After hearing from all the groups any responses not already heard can be raised by the groups and added to the list.
- Following this reporting back on this and the next session the participants will be asked to go through a dotmocracy exercise on the flip charts at the front to identify which of these hopes and concerns are the most important to them.

Part 2 – Developing the Secondary Plan + Urban Design Principles (45 minutes total)

- The draft list of principles (available on the table) that were prepared by the Steering Committee will be presented to the group by pA at the beginning of this session.
- Using both the Steering Committee list and the list of hopes and concerns that the group prepared in Part 1, each small group should work together to modify or add to the list of principles for the study area. These principles should address where things could go in the study area but also what they could look like.
- Each group will present two of their proposed changes or comments or new principles to the larger group. After hearing from all the groups, any responses not already mentioned can be raised by the groups.
- Following the reporting back session, the entire group will be asked to participate in a dotmocracy exercise to identify the principles that are most important to them.

Part 3 - Building on the Principles (30 min)

- Using the list of principles, each group should use the base maps available at the tables, the markers and post-it notes to sketch their preliminary ideas for the study area – including where things could go and/or what they could look like.
- Each group will have limited time to present the key elements of their drawings t the larger group.
