# AMENDMENT NUMBER 319

## TO THE OFFICIAL PLAN

#### OF THE VAUGHAN PLANNING AREA

The following text and Schedule "1" to Amendment Number 319 to the Official Plan of the Vaughan Planning Area constitutes Amendment Number 319.

Also attached hereto, but not constituting part of the Amendment is Appendix I.



## I PURPOSE

The purpose of this Amendment is to amend Amendment Number 107 to the Official Plan of the Vaughan Planning Area (Vaughan-400 Industrial Estates) in order to provide an exception to the general industrial policies to exempt the subject lands from policies which do not permit a restaurant in Industrial Areas.

#### II LOCATION

The lands subject to this Amendment are on Blocks 20 and 21, Plan 65M-2545, at the southwest corner of Edgeley Boulevard and Pennsylvania Avenue, being Units #24, #25 and #26 of the more easterly of the two existing industrial buildings, located at 358 Edgeley Boulevard, in the Vaughan-400 Industrial Estates.

# III <u>BASIS</u>

The decision to amend the Official Plan is based on the following considerations:

- 1. The subject lands are designated "Industrial" by OPA #107, as amended. The predominant use of the land in areas so designated shall be for industrial purposes. The proposed restaurant use does not conform to the "Industrial Area" provisions of the plan and, therefore, an amendment to the Official Plan is required.
- 2. On March 29, 1989, the Council of Town of Vaughan considered the Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendment applications at a Council public meeting. At the meeting, Council approved the Official Plan Amendment application.

# IV DETAILS OF THE ACTUAL AMENDMENT AND POLICIES RELATIVE THERETO

Amendment Number 107 to the Official Plan of the Vaughan Planning Area is hereby amended by adding the following subparagraph to Section 2.2.1:


"2.2.1(n) Notwithstanding the provisions of subparagraph 2.2.1(a), on the lands being Blocks 20 and 21, Plan 65M-2545, located at the southwest corner of Edgeley Boulevard and Pennsylvania Avenue, a single restaurant may be permitted within the combined floor areas of Units #24, #25 and #26 of the easterly industrial building."

#### V <u>IMPLEMENTATION</u>

It is intended that the policies of the Official Plan of the Vaughan Planning Area pertaining to the subject lands shall be implemented through an amendment to the Vaughan Zoning By-law.

#### VI INTERPRETATION

The provisions of the Official Plan of the Vaughan Planning Area as amended from time to time regarding the interpretation of that Plan shall apply with respect to this Amendment.



#### APPENDIX I

The subject lands are located at 358 Edgeley Boulevard at the southwest corner of Edgeley Boulevard and Pennsylvania Avenue, being on Blocks 20 and 21, Plan 65M-2545, Town of Vaughan.

The Official Plan policies in OPA #107 (Vaughan-400 Industrial Park) do not permit restaurants outside of those areas designated "Service Commercial" by OPA #107. This amendment provides an exception to the industrial area policies contained in OPA #107 to facilitate the use of Units #24, #25 and #26 on this property for a single restaurant.

Vaughan Council at its March 29, 1989 Public Hearing resolved:

"That Official Plan Amendment Application OP.94.88 and Zoning By-law Amendment Application Z.183.88 (Simdapa Limited) BE APPROVED."
